How we use and with whom we share the personal information we gather - We assure you that the personal information we gather from you is used by us only as explained below.

- Certain types of our products and services require that we compare some of the information in your application to information contained in a third-party database or with some other third party source. We do this in order to authenticate your identity and other attributes, and also to prevent identity theft. We have confidentiality agreements in place with these third-party databases restricting the disclosure of your information.
- We may use the information you submit to contact you to discuss the support, renewal, and purchase of our products and services. We may also provide the information you have submitted to us to business partners or independent resellers (either within or outside the United States) so that they can contact you and facilitate the support, renewal, and purchase of our products and services. However, any business partner or independent reseller who contacts you for one of these purposes has agreed to use the information we supply only in accordance with a confidentiality agreement.
- Certain types of our products and services come with additional third-party services or products. If you purchase one of these products and services, we may forward some or all of the information in your application to third party providers so that they can provide you with the services and follow up with you directly regarding their services or an upgrade.
