

GlobalSign provides two identity verification options to Code Signing subscribers:

1) **Organization:**

Please ensure that you enter the **Common Name** (e.g. Organization name) and **Address** in your application exactly as it is registered including Inc, Ltd, NV, Plc - if changes to your address have not been updated in your local business directories or Government databases, you may be asked for additional documentation to help with processing your order.

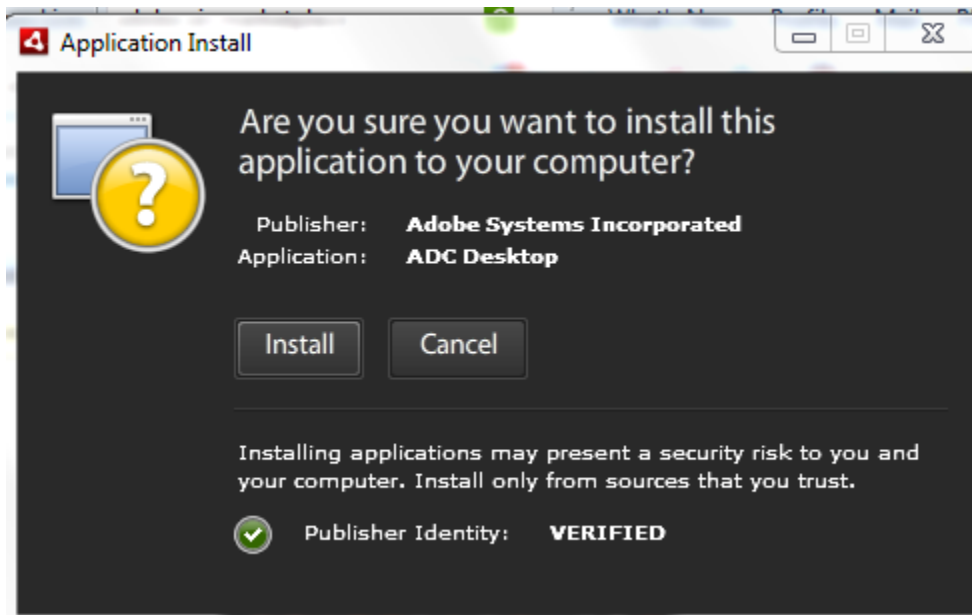
2) **Natural Persons (Individuals)**

Please ensure that you enter the **Common Name (e.g. full legal name e.g. John David Smith)** and **Address** in your application exactly as it is registered - if changes to your address have not been updated in your local third party directories or Government databases, you may be asked for additional documentation to help with processing your order. **Please consult GlobalSign support for a list of unsupported countries.**

Depending upon which option is specified; GlobalSign will perform identity verification as detailed in the GlobalSign Certificate Practice Statement (CPS) <http://www.globalsign.com/repository/>

Subsequent to certificate issuance, you can sign your code (see list of supported platforms <http://www.globalsign.com/code-signing/>). The following examples illustrate how your Publisher name will be displayed in an Adobe AIR installation utilizing an Organizational and Individual- based code signing digital ID.
